

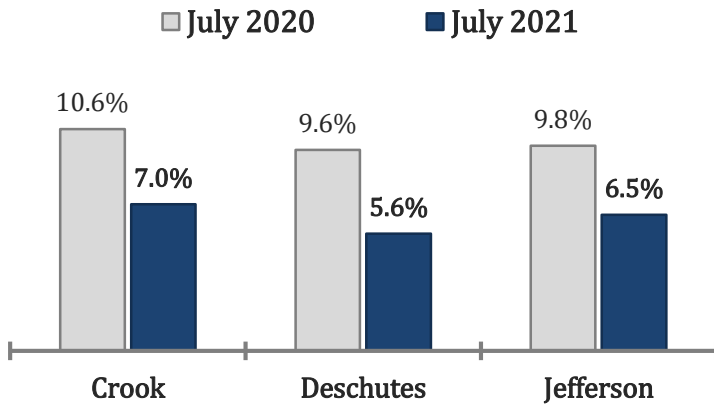

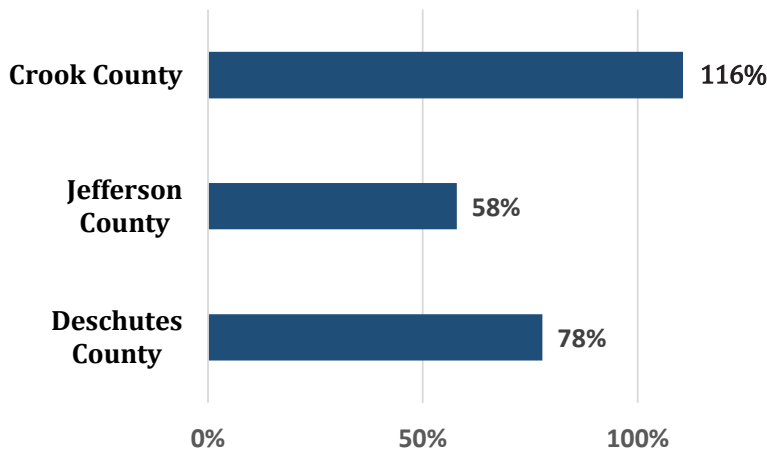
Local Area Unemployment Rates (Seasonally adjusted)

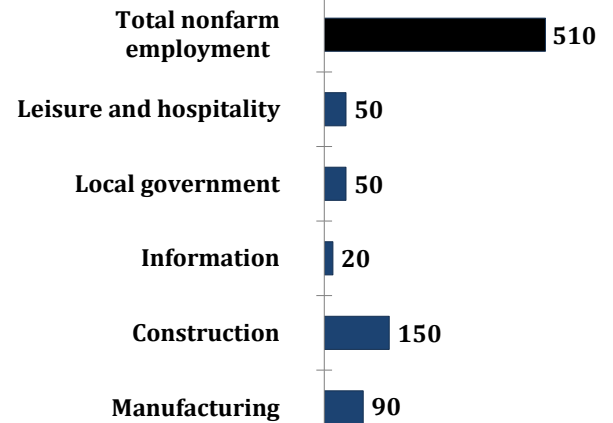


As the labor market supply has tightened to levels similar to pre-pandemic levels, job gains have slowed. In fact, hiring across all three counties underperformed normal seasonal expectations for the Spring.

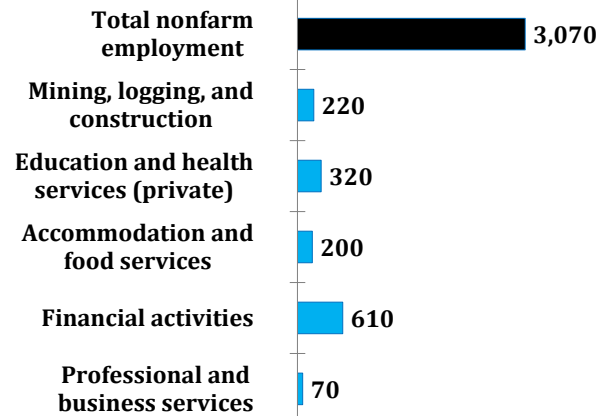
Each county has reached a different milestone in its respective economic recovery. Crook County has fully recovered from its initial job losses with 16% more jobs than it had in February 2020, while Jefferson County has regained 58%, and Deschutes County has regained 78% of its initial job losses.

Select Industry Gains and Losses (Over-the-year net employment change)

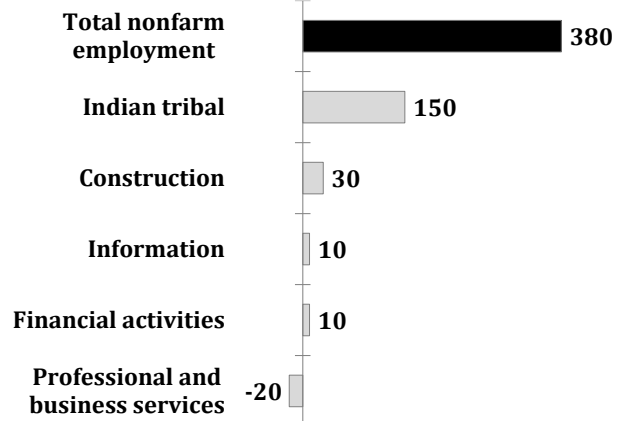
Crook County
