

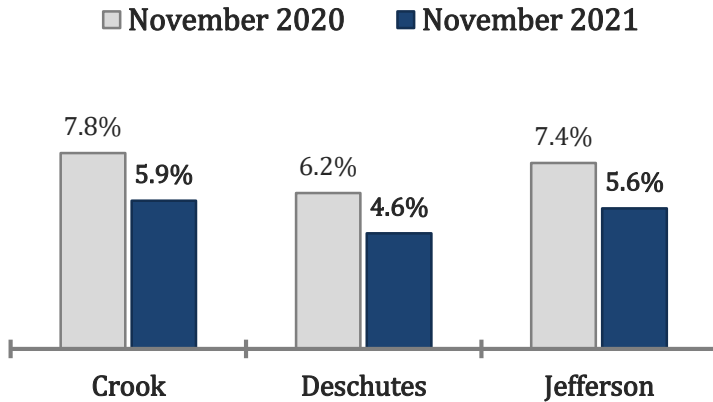

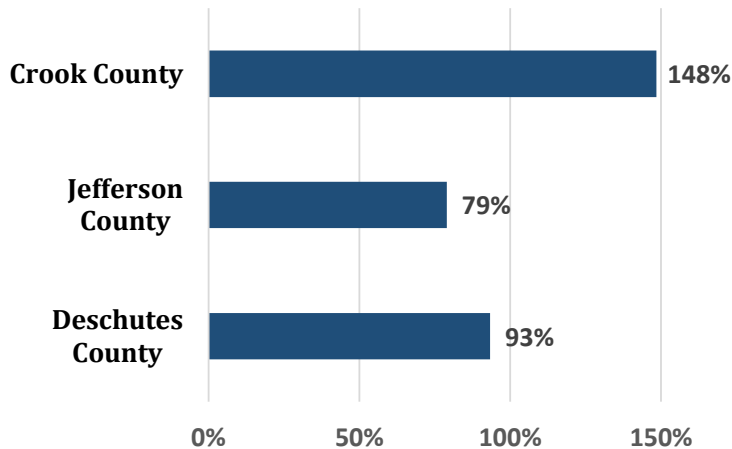

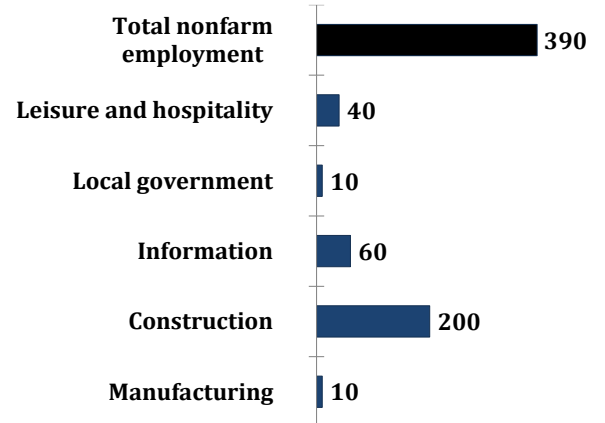


As the labor market supply has tightened to levels similar to pre-pandemic levels, job gains have slowed. Over the six months ending in November, employment in Deschutes County grew by 1.4% while Crook County grew by 1.7%. For comparison, Oregon grew by 2.7%.

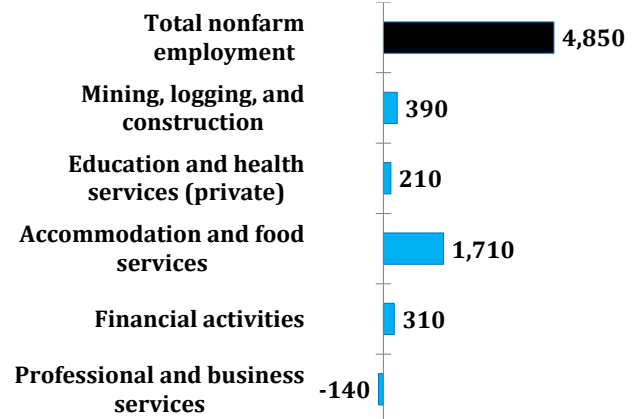
Each county has reached a different milestone in its respective economic recovery. Crook County has fully recovered from its initial job losses with more jobs than it had in February 2020, while Jefferson County has regained 79%, and Deschutes County has regained 93% of its initial job losses.

Select Industry Gains and Losses (Over-the-year net employment change)

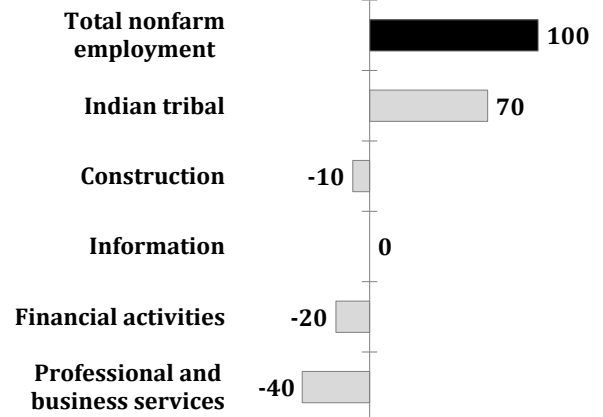
Crook County
