

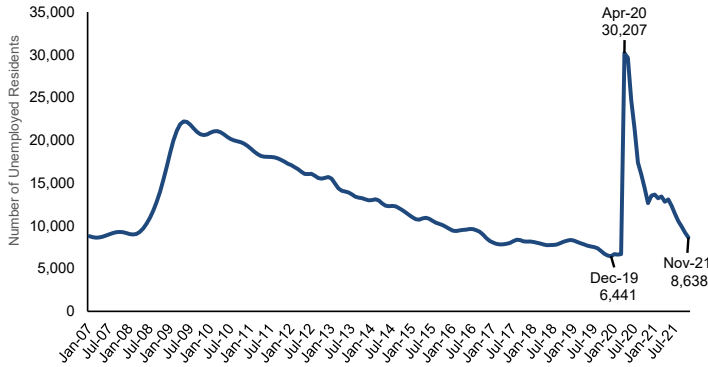

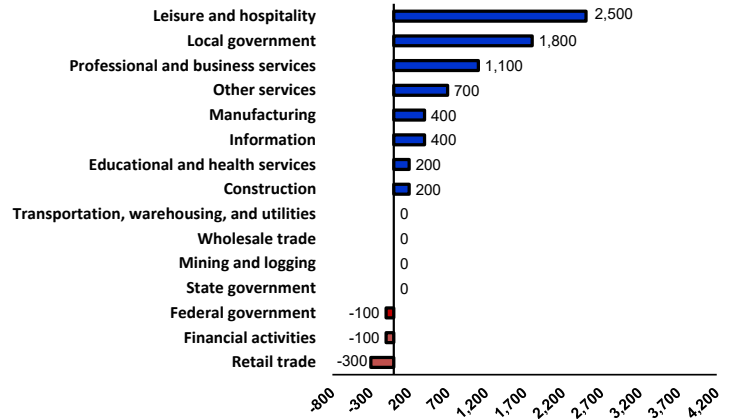

(seasonally adjusted)

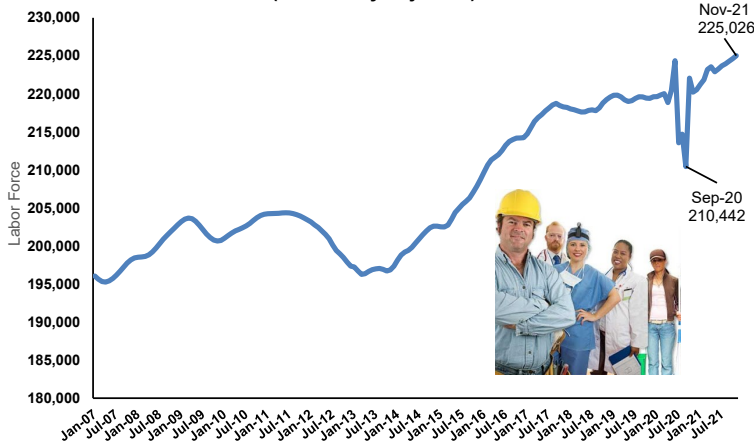


Year-to-Year Change in Industry Employment

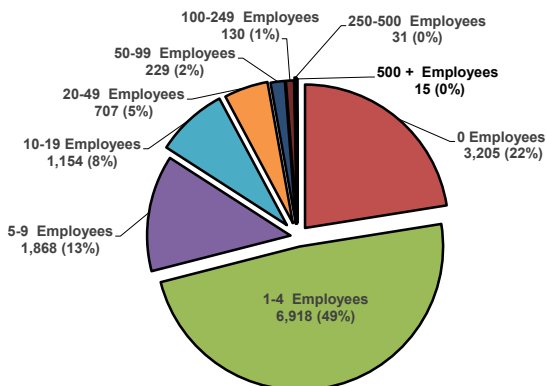
Civilian Labor Force Continues to Grow
Clackamas County: 2019-2021
(seasonally adjusted)



The number of unemployed residents in Clackamas County continues to drop and the labor force tops record numbers.

- The *seasonally adjusted* unemployment rate fell to 3.8% in November from 4.1% in the previous month. The number of unemployed residents fell by -558 to 8,638 in November from 9,196 in the previous month.
- Year-to-year job growth in November showed a gain of 6,800 jobs with the majority of job growth in leisure and hospitality (2,500), local government (1,800), and professional and business services (1,100).
- The labor force (residents working or actively seeking work) continues to grow and reached 225,026 in November. This is the highest labor force number on record for Clackamas County.

Seventy-one percent of private employers in Clackamas County had less than 5 employees in 2021/q1.

- Clackamas County had a total of 14,257 private industry employers providing 137,690 jobs in 2021/q1.
- The majority of employers (71%) had 0-4 employees in the first quarter of 2021 and provided 12,630 jobs.
- Businesses with less than 20 employees made up 92% of all employers and provided 40,368 jobs.
- Large employers, with 100+ employees, made up only 1.2% of businesses but provided 60,538 jobs.
